

Pyoderma Gangrenosum (PG) Study

Have you been diagnosed with Pyoderma Gangrenosum?

OHSU is conducting a clinical research study for PG. Our goal is to determine the safety and effectiveness of Baricitinib (the study drug) for the treatment of PG.

Who may qualify to participate?

- Over 18 years of age
- Have been clinically diagnosed with Pyoderma Gangrenosum (PG)
- Diagnosis of at least one PG ulcer by clinical, histological, and laboratory assessments with a minimum wound size of 4cm
- Able and willing to travel to OHSU for approximately 6 in-person study visits
- Able and willing to participate in approximately 5 remote video conference visits. This includes access to a computer/smartphone with internet and webcam capabilities

Study length: 36 weeks

Required visits: Approximately 11 visits

Reimbursements: \$75-\$175 for time and travel
